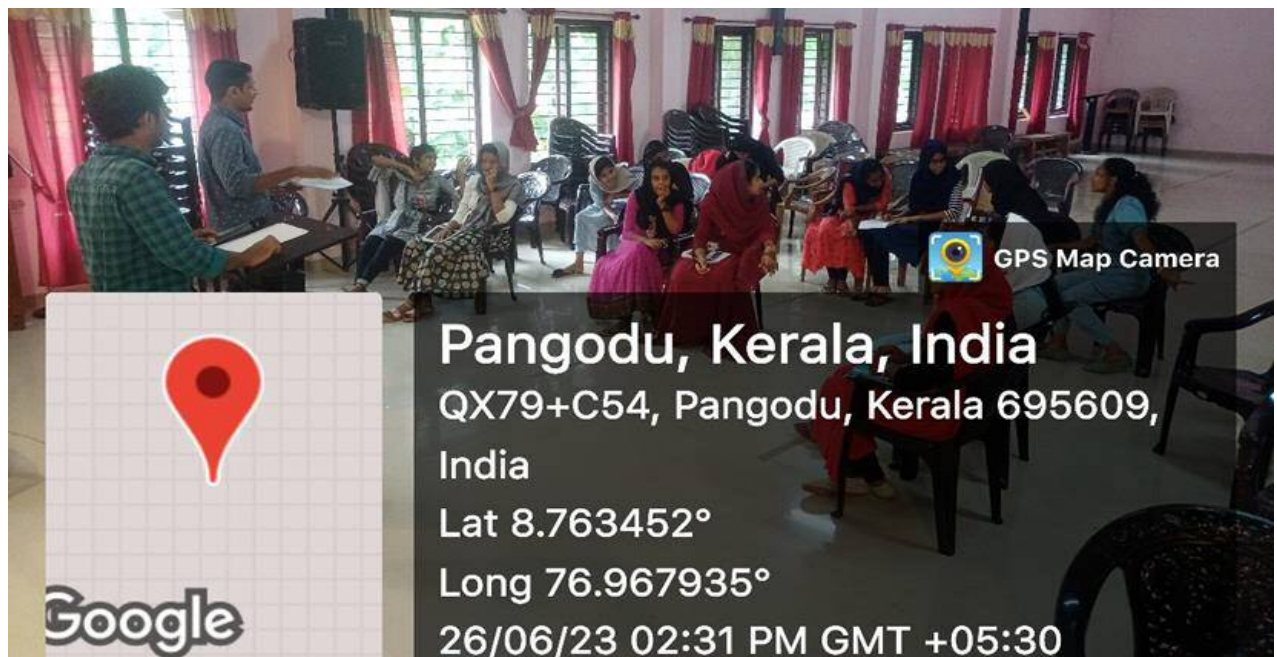
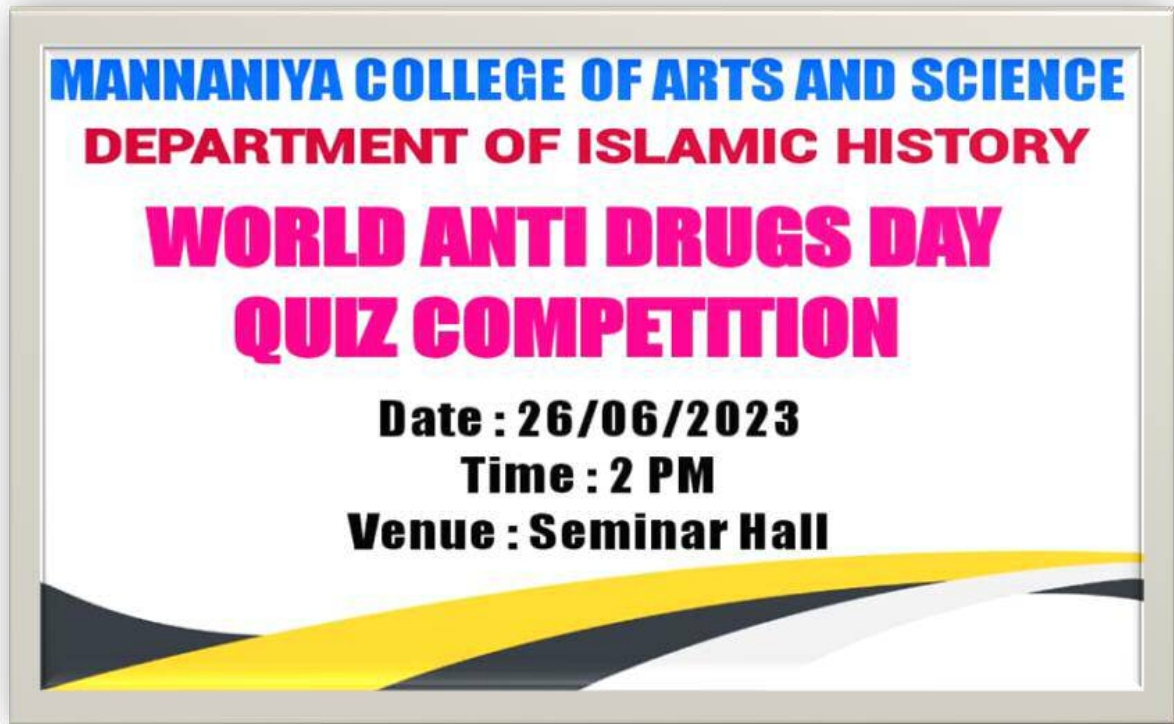
9. REPUBLIC DAY (26/01/2024)

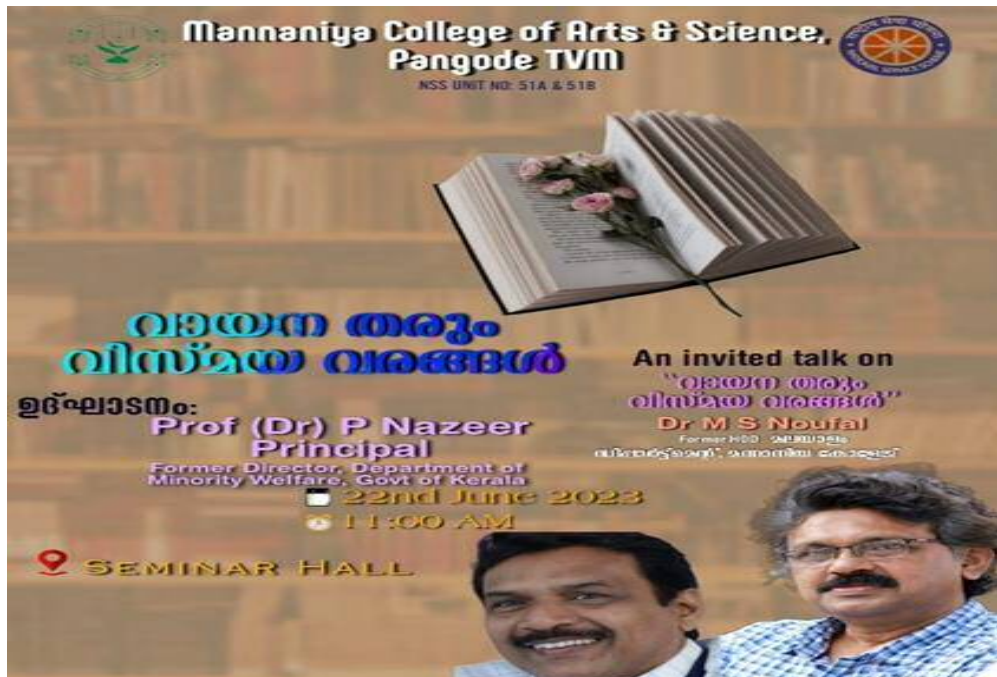

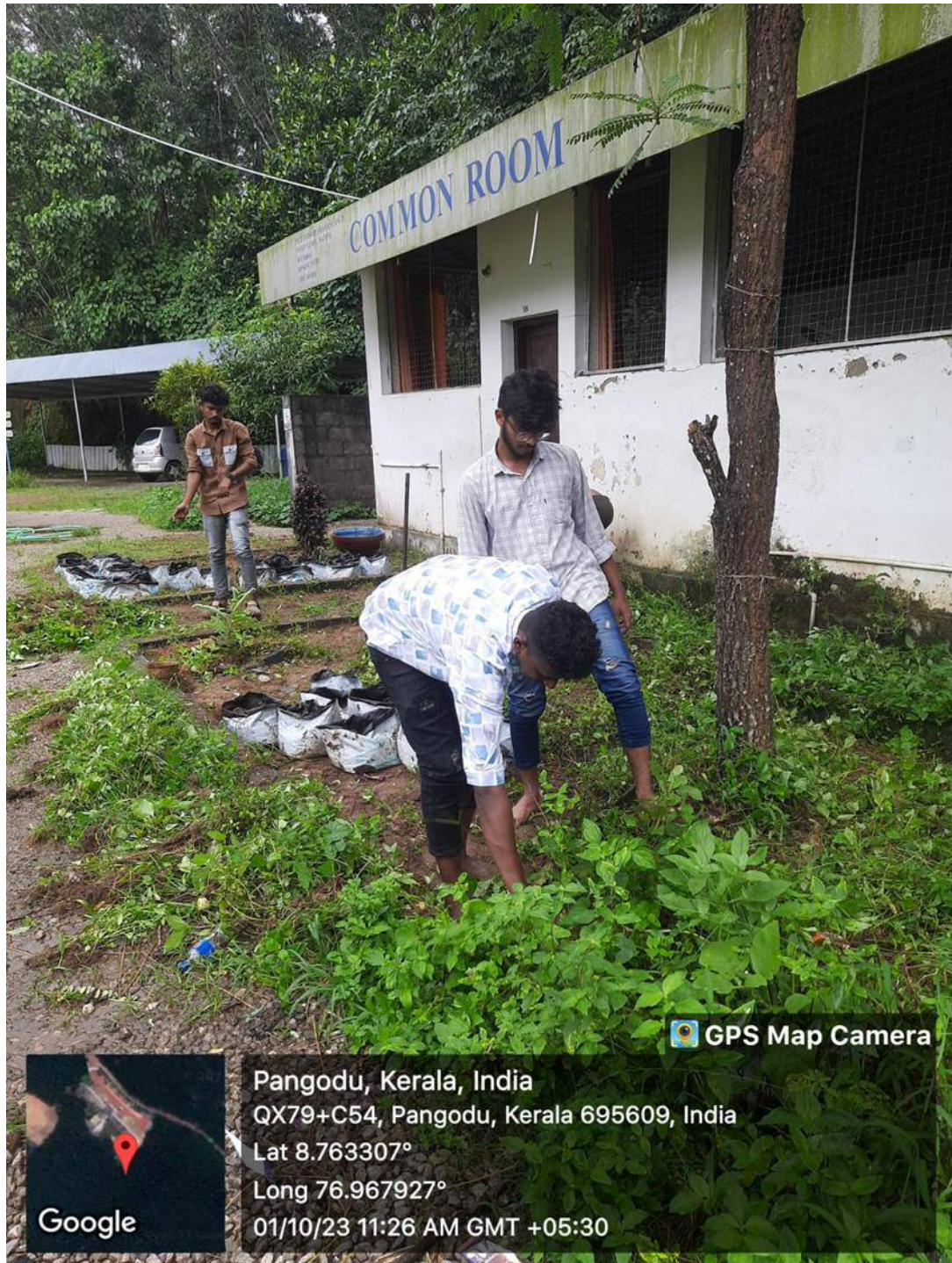

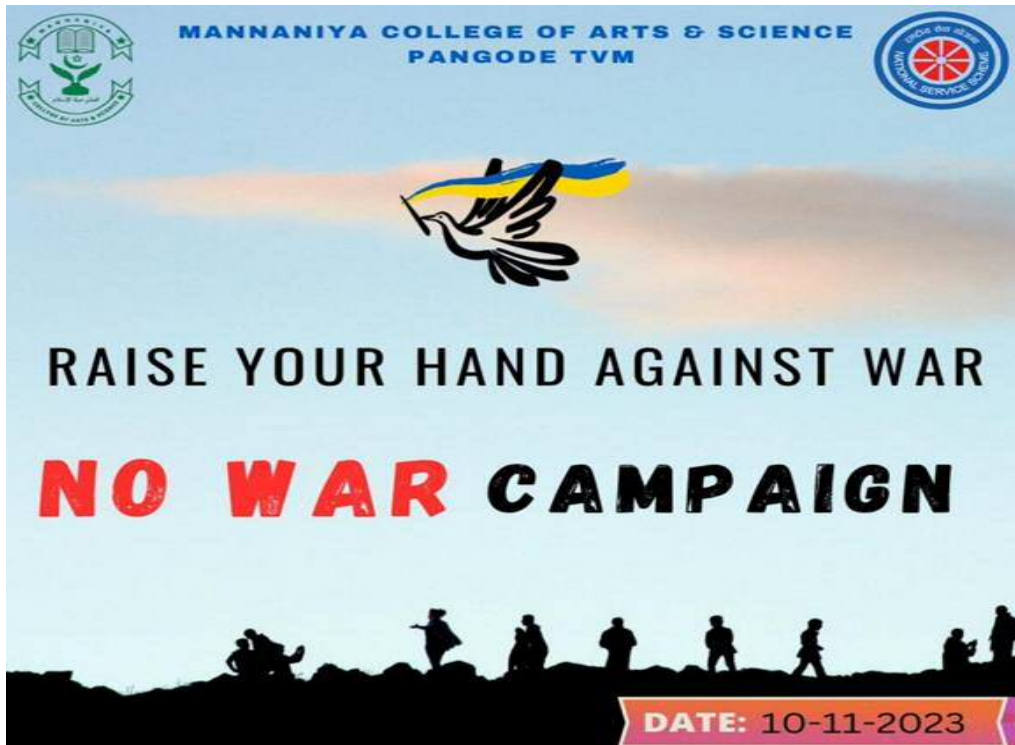
